

The margin of error indicates the percentage points the results may differ from the overall population.









Participant Gender

Household Social Class





research

Desire to have better spoken Irish

- Majority of people (66%) express regret over not having better spoken Irish
- 74% of respondents mention a desire to have better spoken Irish

The Irish Language central to our National Identity

- 73% agree that the language is essential to the identity of the Irish people. This is highest among those aged 35-44 (81%)
- 70% state that Ireland would be culturally impoverished without the Irish language
- 64% of respondents call on the government to do more to support Gaeltacht communities and ensure the future of the Irish language





Commercial Value of the Irish Language

- 42% of respondents express an interest in holidaying in Gaeltacht areas
- 55% of respondents would welcome more advertising in the Irish language




